- Choose your preferred format: audio, e-text or braille. Download materials or receive by mail.
- Read your books using a DAISY player, computer or portable device, tablet or phone.
- Free access available to educators and support professionals.
- Access Bookshare's collection through celalibrary.ca

All you need is your public library card to access this free service.
